Todd asking about removing chain link fence on the right at main entrance, need to confirm boundaries with Town.

Stacey asked if she could get yearly stipend early; Donna not in favor, says it may set a precedence for other departments. Todd will ask the Town first. It was decided via text messages on November 3, 2023 to cut checks on December 1, 2023 but not sooner.
