2. Business – old/new

3. Community Engagement/Growth Initiative
 - A. Event with Lisbon Library held on Thursday, 5/18 at 1:00 PM.

 - iii. Remember that for events the deadlines are fixed based on the date of the event, and that needs be considered by those volunteering to assist.

 - B. Joint Programming Landaff, Lyman will be the Loon education from the Loon Preservation Committee. The date will be September 21st from 6:00 – 7:00 PM.
 - a. RP is coordinating with the Lisbon Area Historical Society to host in their newly opened location.
 - b. RP will coordinate with ACT as a co-sponsor so that we can utilize their online reservation system through the ACT website.

Lots positive body language. Two teachers stayed after to show enthusiasm. Some ideas generated are a Bioblitz, starting a Conservation Club, composting & recycling education. Promising start to working together in the future. GG & KB created a document with an overview of the Lisbon CC. This should be made available on the Town Website.

KB to send all members a survey to pick a (potentially) new time and day with the goal of not bumping up against the Select Board Meetings AND to make the time more accessible to potential members who are working.
