Selectmen's Meeting Minutes
Meeting Date: April 8, 2013

Selectmen Present: Michael Carver (MC), Peter Nightingale (PN), Conrad Farnham (CF)
Administrative Assistant: Barbara Menchin

MC opened the meeting at 3:00 pm

Bills and manifests were approved. MC made a motion to approve the minutes for the April 1, 2013 meeting, PN 2nd so voted.

SELECTBOARD:

Mr. David Graham (Lisbon Stump Jumpers) spoke to MC regarding the 250th celebration banner the snowmobile club had used at their most recent races. Mr. Graham stated he would allow the town to hang the banner from the town building if the Board would like. After discussion MC made a motion to hang the banner, PN 2nd, so voted.

MC received correspondence from Emergency Management regarding the Town of Lisbon receiving emergency operations radios for the town through a grant.

The Board stated that they thought CF should take a field trip to the various water and wastewater facilities. BM to contact Mr. Terri Welch (Welch's Water and Wastewater) to make an appointment.

CF asked the Board regarding the meeting hours regarding meeting every other week unless there is a need to meet weekly as some other towns only meet bi-weekly. MC stated he preferred the weekly meetings but after PN has his schedule change, the meeting time will change to a later time of day.

PN moved to enter non-public session per RSA 91-A:3 II (c) for the purpose of discussing a personnel issue. MC 2nd. All members voted in favor taking BM with them.

Resumed public session. MC moved to seal the minutes. PN 2nd. So voted all.

ADMINISTRATIVE ASSISTANT:

BM reminded the Board that they had a Department Head Meeting on Wednesday, April 17, 2013 at 7:30 am.

BM spoke to the Board regarding the shutting off of certain street lights in town to help cut the costs of street lighting. CF stated he would look into some of the lights to see if they are necessary. BM stated that Mr. Tanis "Joe" Tavernier (Lisbon Police Chief) was also having some of the officers check into this. There are 139 lights in town at the cost of \$20,000.00.

BM informed CF that there would be a Work Session for new Board members in Gorham on April 23.

BM stated she had called LGC Property Liability to ask about if they had a vandalism policy for the cemeteries. LGC stated they did not. BM stated she would continue with the Policy that the Cemetery Association had.

BM informed the Board that the Highway Department had been making appointments with various town's people to have new meters installed.

PUBLIC INPUT: Fred Garofalo (Lisbon/Lyman/Landaff Recycling Center)

FG spoke to the Board regarding the need for an additional person who would be qualified and licensed (per state law) to work at the recycling center in case of an illness while someone is on vacation or leave. He further stated Mr. Lester Bousquet allowed his license to lapse as he was no longer a full-time person. The Board suggested talking to Mr. Kevin Clement (Lisbon Department of Public Works) to see if they could possibly assist in that case. Also it was suggested the FG speak with the Lancaster Recycling

Center to see if necessary, if they could assist.

MC made a motion to adjourn, CF 2nd, so voted.
