Board of Selectmen Minutes 05/13/2013

Selectmen's Meeting Minutes
Meeting Date: May 13, 2013

Selectmen Present: Michael Carver (MC), Conrad Farnham (CF), Peter Nightingale (PN) absent
Administrative Assistant: Barbara Menchin

MC opened the meeting at 3:00 pm

Bills and manifests were approved. MC made a motion to approve the minutes for the May 6, 2013 meeting, CF 2nd so voted.

SELECTBOARD:

MC moved to enter non-public session per RSA 91-A:3 II (c) for the purpose of discussing several Buffington Fund applications. CF 2nd. All members voted in favor taking BM with them.

Resumed public session. MC moved to seal the minutes. CF 2nd. So voted all.

ADMINISTRATIVE ASSISTANT:

BM gave the Board the first issue of the 2013 tax warrant, stating JT will process the bills after she sends out her tax liens.

BM spoke to the Board regarding the roof bids for the Water/Wastewater plants. The Board decided they would like to speak with Mr. Kevin Clement (Department of Public Works) for his input.

BM told the Board that Ms. Fran Day (Upstage Players) had requested to meet with the Board on Monday, May 20, 2013 at 4:00 pm.

BM informed the Board she had received a phone call from Ms. Florence Webb regarding the need to have a key to get into the Railroad Station basement to put storage. During the conversation with Ms. Webb, it was stated she had someone coming in to install shelves. The Board stated there would be no installed shelves to the railroad station but she could still have self-standing shelves. CF stated he would speak with Mr. Roger Robar regarding the key to the Railroad Station basement and that the key needs to be brought to the Town Hall as the Railroad Station is a Town Building.

TOWN CLERK/TAX COLLECTOR: Jennifer Trelfa

JT informed the Board that she had contacted the State regarding Lisbon being able to do State Municipal Agent. The State gave the same answer as they have previously. JT then called Mr. Ray Burton (Governor's Council). JT received another phone call from the State saying that she would be able to start training for the State portion by the end of June.

JT spoke to the Board regarding a property owner who has not paid taxes since 2008. She stated he had told her he wanted to speak with the Board. The last time he had paid anything towards his tax bills was July 2012.

MC made a motion to adjourn, CF 2nd, so voted.
