Selectmen's Meeting Minutes
Meeting Date: August 26, 2013

Selectmen Present: Michael Carver (MC), Peter Nightingale (PN), Conrad Farnham (CF)

MC opened the meeting at 3:00 pm

Bills and manifests were approved. MC made a motion to approve the minutes for the August 12, 2013 meeting, PN 2nd so voted.

SELECTBOARD:

The Board reviewed an application for Railroad Station and Town Hall use. Both were approved.

PN moved to enter non-public session per RSA 91-A:3 II (c) for the purpose of discussing a Buffington Fund application. MC 2nd. All members voted in favor taking BM with them.

Resumed public session. MC moved to seal the minutes. PN 2nd. So voted all.

ADMINISTRATIVE ASSISTANT:

BM informed the Board that she had a recent conversation with the Town of Lyman regarding dump stickers. The Town of Lyman requires their residents to get stickers to go to the Lisbon/Lyman/Landaff Recycling Center. It was recently overheard by a Lyman resident that Lisbon does not enforce dump stickers. The Board of Selectmen for the Town of Lyman would like to discuss the sticker situation at the next annual meeting they have with the Lisbon Board of Selectmen. The Board requested BM to discuss the situation with Mr. Fred Garafolo (Lisbon/Lyman/Landaff Recycling Center) to see how he feels about the dump stickers.

The new hours for the selectmen's office will be Monday 9 to 6, Tuesday, Wednesday, Thursday and Friday 9 to 5.

BM asked the Board if in the advertisement for the sale of Town property to be held in October, if the Board wanted to place a minimum bid on those properties. PN made a motion to have no minimum bid, MC second. So voted. The Board also requested BM to place in the ad "The Town reserves the right to reject all bids the Board of Selectmen deem not in the best interest of the Town." PN further stated he would recuse himself from the bid openings.

DEPARTMENT HEAD: Jody Gagnon (Lisbon Life Squad)

PN moved to enter non-public session per RSA 91-A:3 II (c) for the purpose of discussing a personnel issue. MC 2nd. All members voted in favor.

Resumed public session. MC moved to seal the minutes. PN 2nd. So voted all.

DEPARTMENT HEAD: Jennifer Trelfa (Town Clerk/Tax Collector)

JT spoke to the Board regarding deed notices and when she would be moving forward with the deed process. JT also spoke about the meeting she had with the Budget Advisory Committee.

PUBLIC INPUT: Upstage Players (Donna Northrop)

Ms. Northrop stated the Upstage Players would be clear of the upstairs of the Town Hall by October 1, 2013. The Board stated that there had been a problem with while the Upstage Players were cleaning the last time that they had blocked the Life Squad door and that a window had been broken. The Board suggested the Upstage Players and the Town build a wall so that they could continue storing their clothing and sets at the Town building. PN asked about the upcoming performance which is to be Fiddler on the Roof. Ms. Northrop stated the performance would be November 1st, 2nd and 3rd and November 8th, 9th and 10th. Ms. Northrop gave the Board her rehearsal dates and took an application for Town Hall use to be submitted back to the Board for approval.

PN made a motion to adjourn, CF 2nd, so voted.
