## Board of Selectmen Minutes 09/04/2012

### Town of Lisbon

Selectmen's Meeting Minutes  
Meeting Date: September 4, 2012

Selectmen Present: Ruth Robar (RAR), Peter Nightingale (PN), Michael Carver (MC)  
Town Administrator: Joe Wiggett (absent)  
Administrative Assistant: Barbara Menchin

RAR opened the meeting at 4:00 pm

Bills and manifests were approved. PN made a motion to accept the minutes of the August 27, 2012 Board meeting, RAR 2<sup>nd</sup>, so voted.

#### **SELECTBOARD:**

The Board discussed properties on South Main Street that are up for deeding.

PN spoke regarding the recent incident on Hodge Hill Road where the Lisbon Life Squad had taken the ambulance to assist someone in need. As the ambulance was driving up the road, it hit a serious rut and broke the U-bolts to the rear axle. The Board was informed that a letter could be written to the homeowners on the road stating they would only be able to rescue someone after they have gotten equipment such as an OHRV or pickup truck to make the call as the ambulance would not be able to make the road safely. Furthermore, insurance companies can be contacted and their homeowner insurance could be cancelled. The Board stated they would have JW write a letter to the residents.

The Board talked about the property that is owned by the Presby Trust located on Ecology Drive.

The Board discussed the naming of the road that will connect the Oregon Road to the Pearl Lake Roads. MC made a motion to name it Muchmore Road, PN 2<sup>nd</sup>, so voted.

#### **DEPARTMENT HEAD:** Fred Garofalo (Lisbon/Lyman/Landaff Recycling Center)

FG spoke to the Board regarding contracting for recycling bags and explained that this cannot be done due to price fluctuations. He stated the current price he has received is \$13,647.00. He stated he would purchase the bags in December.

FG informed the Board that recycling revenue was down by \$2,600.00.

FG stated he had received a letter from the Department of Environmental Services regarding an area of erosion that needs to be monitored. He further stated this area was not a threat.

FG spoke to the Board regarding the disposal of glass. He stated the glass could be shipped to Littleton and crushed and then returned to the Town of Lisbon or perhaps he could get some assistance from the Highway Department on occasion. The Board stated they would request JW contact the Towns of Landaff and Lyman to see if they would be willing to assist.

#### **PUBLIC INPUT:** Rob Brooks

The Board discussed the finishing of the painting of the Town Hall. As Mr. Brooks did not include the open porch area, the Board requested Mr. Brooks to clean the ceiling, wall and trim and to repaint the entry door for an additional \$500.00. The Board stated they would get a volunteer to finish painting the section in front of the Police Department and the lettering on the building.

MC made a motion to adjourn, PN 2<sup>nd</sup>, so voted all.
