MC opened the meeting at 3:05 pm

DEPARTMENT HEAD: Chief Tavernier presented the Board with a letter from residents of the Lisbon Inn. They are requesting a change in the parking in front of the Inn. The parking spot that now exist blocks the view for those trying to pull out of the Inn parking lot. Chief Tavernier talked to the Highway Dept. they had no objections to changing the parking spot into emergency parking only, keeping it free most of the time. The highway department will also replace the two hour parking signs. MC made a motion to change parking spot in question to an emergency parking spot. PN 2nd all voted in favor.

TREASURER: Ruth Robar came in to speak to the board about the need to borrow against the TAN. The board discussed the amount that will be needed until the end of the year.

SELECTMEN'S OFFICE:

The Board was informed that someone from Carol Coppola's & Assoc. will be here on Wednesday to start to correct the accounting.

SELECTMEN'S BUSINESS: MC made motion to accept minutes PN 2nd so voted all.

TAX COLLECTOR/TOWN CLERK: MC made motion to go into non-public to discuss personnel matter with Jennifer Trelfa. CF 2nd All voted to take Jennifer Trelfa and Suzanne Tavenier into non public

PUBLIC: The board reviewed a quote to clean up water tanks. Selectmen talked about other bids Mr. Welch has. Board requested selectmen's office calls Mr. Welch and ask him to forward the quotes for morning.

SELECTMEN'S OFFICE: The Board was informed that the printer was again in need of service. The cost to fix was a little over 650.00 The Board reviewed quote and price for new printer which was 699.99. The Board voted in favor of ordering new printer.

The Board was told that John Trumbull would be in Wednesday to finish the information needed to send in the town's MS-1

TAX COLLECTOR: Jennifer Trelfa presented the Board with a property to deed. MC made motion to deed property PN 2nd all voted in favor

BUFFINTON FUND: PN made motion to enter into nonpublic as per (RSA 91:a3II)MC 2nd so voted all.

SELECTMEN'S BUSINESS: The Board did not receive any bids on the Town Property for sale. The Board decided to re-advertise.

PUBLIC IMPUT: Dave Armstrong spoke to the board about Bishop Road and concerns about the condition of the road. The Board spoke on this and stated that the Highway Dept. is aware of the conditions of the road. Mr. Armstrong asked about the pot

holes and asked if there were any future plans to work on the road. PN stated he would discuss Mr. Armstrong concerns with the Highway Dept. at the next Department Head Meeting.
