Approval of minutes from October 21, 2019: Brian Higgins made a motion to approve the October 21 minutes as written and Arthur Boutin seconded the motion. All were in favor of the motion.

Historical Society: The historical society came before the board with a new position of the building they would like to build. Scott Champagne (Chair) stated that he reviewed the plans and only has one concern. That concern is the way the new building is positioned could pose a problem for any tractor trailer unit that was coming up Depot Street. He stated the way the building sits it would make it a tight squeeze for a tractor trailer to come up Depot Street. Scott stated he would like to know the distances/dimensions of L2 through L5. Frank Barrett (Architect) stated he wasn't sure why there wasn't a legend on the plans but there should be. Scott Champagne (Chair) stated that he would really like to see what those distances are before he says yes to something, he is unsure of. The

historical society stated they would reach out to Tom Smith to see if he can provide the dimensions. The board stated that once they have the dimensions and review them, they will discuss at the next board meeting and send the historical society an email. The historical society was in agreeance with this.

MS-535: Greg Colby (Finance Director) completed the Ms-535 for the period ending December 31, 2018. All board members reviewed and signed off on.

Littleton Monument Company Bill: A bill came to the town from the Littleton Monument Company in reference to names that were added to the Veterans Memorial at the white church. Scott Champagne (Chair) stated that he had spoken to Littleton Monument Company already and stated that he would call them and have the bill redone and made out to the Lisbon's Lions Club as they are the ones responsible for the bill not the town.

LUCT Paperwork: Mary Pinkham-Langer who is subcontracted through the towns assessing company to get the gravel pits up to speed has been doing a lot of work lately. Mary recently sent some paperwork that she needed the board to sign off on. The paperwork is Land Use Change Tax documents that need to be recorded at the Registry of Deeds. The first is for Tax Map R17 Lot 17 in the amount of \$34,000.00. The second is Map R27 Lot 11 in the amount of \$0.00. The third is Map R49 Lot 01 in the amount of \$11,500.00 and the fourth is Map R32 Lot 26 in the amount of \$3,100.00. The reason some of the Land Use Change Tax bills are so high are because some of the pits haven't had any land use change tax in 40 years. Scott Champagne (Chair) stated that he knows some of the pit owners will be upset by the large bills but really, they have gotten away without paying for so long.

Budget Meetings: The board will begin meeting with department heads on Wednesday October 30, 2019 at 8 am.

7:46 PM Brian Higgins made a motion to adjourn and Arthur Boutin seconded the motion. All were in favor of the motion.


