Agenda items:

- 1) Review of minutes from March meeting. Tara brought to attention the error that it was recorded a 'Public Meeting' took place and there was none. All agreed it was an error. Motion to accept the minutes, minus the reference to 'Public Hearing', was presented by SC, second SB – all voted in favor, none opposed. The board passed around and signed the minutes.
- 2) Public Input – No public members, other than Tara, were in attendance.
- 3) A discussion was opened concerning the draft version Master Plan second chapter named "Community Profile". Tara brought more data concerning Table 2.6, this was reviewed with discussion.
- 4) Tara also proposed a work plan of items to address and review in the Master Plan, for the remainder of 2019. It shows a breakdown of when efforts are to be placed on Master Plan and Zoning Amendments. All agreed on the plan as proposed.
- 5) Tara had some excellent large printed overhead earth views of Lisbon made, some of which show current 'features' that will be talking points in at the next meeting.
- 6) Christopher Hodge, the Lisbon Building Inspector, reports two building permits were requested. One was an electrical request, and the other request was missing a site plan designating where the house location to be.
- 7) No other business was brought up, a motion to adjourn was made by SB and seconded by MF, all voted in favor, none opposed.
