Agenda items:

- 1) Review of minutes from February meeting.  
Motion to accept as presented by SB, second SC – all voted in favor, none opposed. The board passed around and signed the minutes.
- 2) Public Input – No public member was in attendance.
- 3) ~~Public Hearing~~ <sup>Discussion</sup> was opened concerning the draft version Master Plan second chapter named "Community Profile". Tara reviewed each chart and section with the board. Some questions that were raised could be explained, but some were not. Tara is going to reach out to other possible sources to compare data points targeting these questionable areas. The planning board suggests all town residents look at the important data facts presented in this chapter.
- 4) Christopher Hodge, the Lisbon Building Inspector, reports no permits were requested or reviewed over February 2019.
- 5) RP attended a North Country Regional Transportation Committee meeting where she was introduced to a small business that creates and expands upon bicycle trails and routes. They are specifically interested in Lisbon as it would expand an existing ended route. The thought would be to make a loop using the old rail bed where it can be used, and bring visitors into town for food, resting and tourism.
- 6) No other business was brought up, a motion to adjourn was made by SB and seconded by SC, all voted in favor, none opposed.
