Approval of minutes from September 9, 2019: Arthur Boutin made a motion to accept the September 9th minutes as written and Brian Higgins seconded the motion. All were in favor of the motion.

Deed-Signatures Needed: The deed for the repurchase of the Beckett property on West Street is complete and the board needs to sign so it can be sent to Grafton to be recorded. Arthur Boutin made a motion to sign the deed and Brian Higgins seconded the motion. All were in favor of the motion.

Lisbon Life Squad Donation: A donation was made to the Lisbon Life Squad in the amount of \$250.00 this donation came from Paula Gombas in memory of Allen Gombas. Arthur Boutin made a motion to accept the \$250 donation and Brian Higgins seconded the motion. All were in favor of the motion.

Cargill Contract for Salt: Charlie Hampson (Highway Department Supervisor) provided the board a copy of the winter salt contract as an FYI. Last year's cost of salt was \$85.12 a ton and this year's cost is \$84 a ton so the price has decreased. The board appreciated Charlie sharing the information.

Letter from Rolf Zuk to the Board: Mr. Zuk left a letter at the town building addressed to the board. The town owns the trailer but not the property it sits on. Mr. Zuk stated he is willing to work with the town but needs to have the trailer taken off his property as soon as possible since his employment contract is ending. Krystle Dow (Administrative Assistant) will send the letter that Mr. Zuk provided to the towns attorney and ask what he suggests we do next. Selectman Boutin stated that Mr. Zuk is aware that there is a process that needs to be followed as he was present at last week's meeting.

120 School Street and 1100 Presby Road: The board discussed these two properties that the town took. Signs should go up on the Presby Road Property stating No Trespassing as it is Town property and the board should take inventory of what is there. As far as the 120 School Street Property, Krystle Dow (Administrative Assistant) will reach out to town council and see what the next step is in the evection process.

Quotes on Retaining Wall: The retaining wall closest to the town building where the fence is has been discussed at previous meetings. Winterset gave the town a quote of roughly \$130,000 to complete the job and the town just received another quote from ECS Construction Services in the amount of \$98,428.00. Another discussion will be had on this as it was also discussed to make this a possible warrant article.

Turkeys: Riverside Market called in reference to the town employees getting turkeys for Thanksgiving. Arthur Boutin made a motion to approve giving out turkeys to employees and Brian Higgins seconded the motion. All were in favor of the motion.

6:51 PM Brian Higgins made a motion to adjourn and Arthur Boutin seconded the motion. All were in favor of the motion.


