Item One: There will be a public hearing on the trapping of bobcats in NH on April 1 in Concord. The LCC has sent a letter to Senator Woodburn expressing opposition. Land can be posted against this trapping.

Item Two: The grant request has been funded for the trout stream crossing project for the Ammonoosuc watershed. RP shared a map that will be used in the survey. This survey will be a key part of our land and wildlife inventory. High School students from LRS will participate. Paid interns from Plymouth State will lead the project.

Item Three: A survey is being considered to send to town residents on conservation focus areas. RP shared a sample from Harrisville. A spreadsheet will be created and presented at next meeting.

Item Four: Discussion of research on outdoor lighting and noise reduction. RC presented recommendations on outdoor lighting. BS shared information on noise regulations.

Item Five: The LCC is sponsoring and organizing a roadside trash pick up through New Hampshire the Beautiful. The pick up is scheduled for the weekend of May 14th and 15th. Helpers will pick up bags and gloves at the Railroad Station. RP will pick up and deliver the plastic bags from Epsom, NH on April 9th.
