Meeting of Lisbon Budget Advisory Committee  
October 28, 2014

Meeting called to order at 6:10 PM

The first order of business is to elect a Chairperson; vice-chairperson and secretary. A copy of the bylaws and mission statement (provided to us by the selectmen) was distributed to all.

MOTION BY JAN MARSHALL TO NOMINATE JOHN FITZGERALD AS SECRETARY; SECONDED BY STANDLEY SUDOL. ALL IN FAVOR, MOTION PASSED.

Discussion was held on the budgetary process. Barry handed out a document he had prepared titled 2015 Budget Discussion Points. He explained his thoughts relative to this document.

Public Input: Mr. Wold is here as he is concerned his taxes have shot up a lot since he moved to town 12 years ago. He is zoned commercial though it is a residential house. He also asked if the two big factories in town paid a large amount of taxes similar to what you read about Moore Dam in Littleton. John indicated to him that NEWT paid about 10% of the total taxes to be raised but he should visit the town's website as all the information is available on line now.

Jan Marshall distributed a list of 2014 tax rates for towns DRA has already set this year. This was run as of October 27, 2014.
