

On June 15, 2015, the New Hampshire Department of Environmental Services, Air Resources Division (DES) received a request from Ammonoosuc Asphalt, Inc. to withdraw its Temporary Permit application for a proposed hot mix asphalt plant and diesel generator engine in Lisbon, NH. The purpose of this letter is to inform you that the application has been withdrawn. Due to the withdrawal request, DES is not taking further action with regard to this permit application.

DES notes that it received public testimony and a number of written comments regarding the air permit review process in New Hampshire. In particular, DES received comments on the effect of weather inversions and topography on ambient air impacts, as well as comments on whether ambient air dispersion modeling analyses should be required for all permitted sources. Please be assured that, since these issues are pertinent to the air permitting process in general, they will be still be considered by DES as a policy question moving forward.

DES thanks you for your interest in this project, as well as your concerns about air quality issues in your community. DES also wishes to thank those who attended the May 13, 2015 public hearing and provided oral and written testimony in regard to this application.
