
## **Lisbon Cemetery Association**

## May 1, 2023



Meeting called to order at 5:30 pm

Met at Grove Hill Cemetery to see new lots that were cleared. Finished meeting at Donna's.

March 29, 2023 minutes read and approved. Motion to accept Donna, second by Todd, approved.

Treasurer's report-Stacey, motion to accept Lisa, second by Donna, approved.

Stacey put together letter/announcement of intent to remove trees, shrubs and other greenery from cemetery, to be posted in area newspapers and Town website, effective 11-01-24. Discussed getting a sign to post at cemetery entrance.

Todd researched more on fountain and history, contacting Wally Clough heirs (Tome Clark) Wally was big on history and may have material/pictures to share. Todd also reported discussion with Scott Champagne looking for estimates on paying main road, ~\$20,000.

Donna asked about Salmon Hole history, potential for grant, perhaps a military organization will help. She believes students will help putting flags up.

Todd has students lined up to paint buildings at Grove Hill and has purchased 288 flags for \$587.30, may need more flag holders, some do not have one. Also reported Todd Colby may have some.

Saturday, May 13th meet at Grove Hill to put new flags up, maybe finish on May 20.

Todd reported more stones need to be cleaned and there are several that are leaning or broken. We may need to find someone else, not sure if John Hanks will be able to do them anymore.

Donna emailed Elena to see if they have names of people to help and emailed John Hanks as well. If not able, can they recommend anyone.

We need to get going on recording information to add to Cem Sites again soon.
