ORDINANCE TOWN OF LISBON

In the year one thousand nine hundred and eighty eight

AN ORDINANCE

SECTION I

The selectmen have the authority under RSA 41:11 to regulate the keeping, use, conveying, and places of deposit of gunpowder and other combustible and dangerous material, and may exercise all powers conferred in city councils by paragraphs VII and VIII of RSA 47:17

SECTION II

Pursuant to RSA 47:18, it is forbidden for anyone to store, sell, Class B or Class C fireworks or pyrotechnical materials within the Town of Lisbon without the prior written permission of the Chief of Police or the Board of Selectmen.

SECTION III

It is forbidden for anyone to possess or discharge any Class B or Class C fireworks or pyrotechnical materials within the Town of Lisbon without the prior written permission of the Chief of Police or the Board of Selectmen.

SECTION IV

The penalties for any violation of the preceding ordinance will be \$100.00 fine for each incident involving Class C fireworks or pyrotechnical devises, and \$250.00 for each violation involving Class B fireworks or pyrotechnical devises.

SECTION V

This ordinance is intended to include not only the State Statutes specifically referred to herein by title and number but also include all those State Statutes, including the provisions of Chapter 47 on the New Hampshire Revises Statutes Annotated as amended which are part of the law, and they are included under this section by reference.

SECTION VI

Each separate provision of this Ordinance shall be deemed independent of all other provisions herein and, if any provision of this Ordinance be declared invalid, all other provisions thereof shall remain valid and enforceable.

This Ordinance shall take effect June 15, 1988
