Boundaries of the lot(s) including compass bearings, distances, lot areas, all existing lot lines, easements and rights of way.
Acreage or square feet;

Topographic contours at two (2) ft intervals or 5 ft if applicable (see section 6.02.B);

The location of natural features such as streams, marshes, wetlands, lakes or ponds; and

manmade features such as existing roads and structures. The plan shall indicate which of

these natural or manmade features will be removed, retained or altered;

Roads, streets and driveways within 200' of the site boundary.
As applicable, the width of the traveled way of all proposed streets, driveways and sidewalks within the site, with indication of direction of travel and the inside radii of all curves.
